



Coastside Fishing Club - OPM Classic 2010 Halibut/Striper Derby & BBQ - Sat. June 19th

Summary: Entry fee is \$30 for adults, kids 15 and under (U15s) are free. Fish any port but weigh-in at Oyster Point Marina (So. San Francisco) between 2 & 3 PM. Free Club Sponsored BBQ starts at 2 PM. Winners will determined by weight of either a halibut or striper with a total of \$4,000 awarded as follows: 1st Place - \$1,000, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Place - \$500 each and 6th through 10th Place \$200 each. Kids (U15s) are not eligible for cash prizes but every U15 entered will receive a nice goody bag and the five that bring in the largest fish (by weight) will also win a Shimano Rod & Reel. All entries including U15s will get a Free OPM Classic 2010 Tee Shirt if Entry Form, Entry Fees and ROLs are complete and received by Saturday June 12th. All Teams must have a current Coastside Fishing Club Member on board but it's not necessary that every team member be current.

Explanation & Rules for The Coastside Fishing Club – OPM Classic 2010:

How to register: We encourage everyone to enter and preferably as a team since this will help reduce the paperwork. We ask that each captain send one check and Entry Form for the people fishing on his boat (if possible). This "Form" (Rules, Registration and Release of Liability) will be available online and an updated list of the people registered will be periodically posted at: www.CoastsideFishingClub.com. Please note that anyone 18 and under must have the Release of Liability Form signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Cost: The entry fee is \$30 per person and you can fish by yourself or with as many people as you choose. If an entrant is 15 years old or younger (U15) they will fish for free yet still receive a package worth more than the normal entry fee, however they are not eligible for one of the cash prizes. All entries including U15s whose registration is completed and received on or before June 12th, will receive a Complimentary Tee Shirt. In addition, the adults who weigh the ten largest fish will receive cash awards and the U15s who weigh the three largest fish will receive a rod and reel. All kids who weigh a fish will receive a separate raffle ticket for a chance to win a separate group of prizes (over \$1k value).

Rules:

1. You may fish from any port but the weigh-in will be at Oyster Point Marina, So. San Francisco.
2. You must be pre-registered and have your fish at the official weigh-in site before 3PM.
3. All halibut and stripers will be weighed on a digital scale.
4. Only one fish per person will be weighed and the weigh masters decision will be final.
5. All fish brought to the weigh-in must have been legally caught by hook and line on derby day.
6. Each angler can win only one cash prize (U15s not eligible for cash awards).

Additional rules: In the event of a tie, money for those places will be divided equally between entrants who are tied. Rule infraction(s) will result in the disqualification of the individual(s) involved. If a fish is questionable for any reason whatsoever, that entry is subject to immediate disqualification without recourse.

Deadline: Please return your application with completed Registration & Release of Liability Form and Payment as soon as possible, but it must be postmarked (or already received) ***No Later Than Saturday June 12th***. (the week before). Entries of teams or individuals received after the deadline will not receive a tee shirt.

Who to fish with: In addition to private boats, anglers can fish on any party or six pack boat. Please make your own direct arrangements to fish with the boat of your choice and then pre-register and list whatever you decide as your boat or team name on the application.

Cancellation: This Derby is subject to cancellation at the sole discretion of Coastside Fishing Club.
